




SINGLES

Paul Zinnard started as the lead singer and composer of the band The Bolivians back in 1998. Two years later he founded the band The Pauls with whom he recorded five albums. The last one, *Miss Tokyo Meets Her Lover* (2010) was awarded best album of the year by the Radio 3 show Hoy Empieza Todo. That same year he made his solo artist debut with *Songs of Hatred and Remorse*. A collection of songs presented with an acoustic guitar and a string quartet.
