Outras Trece Cancións Bonitas is the new show by Benxamín Otero and Germán Díaz, based on a selection of melodies that move between traditional music and more contemporary compositions. Galician, Castilian, and Swedish songbooks, as well as references such as Egberto Gismonti and Adriano Celentano, can be heard in this concert.

The medieval sound of the hurdy-gurdy, the elegance of the oboe and the English horn, and the distinctive timbre of mechanical instruments create a unique sonic universe that effectively portrays the new language of popular music.
